

The Angler Bass Overdrive

The Angler Bass Overdrive utilizes a signal recovery circuit to retain a true bass sound combined with a smooth overdrive. This pedal has a huge sound because it is optimized for bass guitar. Most overdrive and distortion units are designed for guitar and cut off the low-end signals crucial to any good bass sound. The Angler also has a built in Line Driver that is always on to improve the fidelity of the signal path: long cables will no longer cause loss of high-end. This pedal is the biggest sounding bass overdrive you will find.

Operation

The Angler Bass Overdrive arrives from Dredge-Tone ready to use, just connect a guitar to the input and an amp to the output, step on the foot switch, turn up the LEVEL and DREDGE controls, set the TONE where you like it, and play. The amount of recovered Bass signal is dependent upon the amount of DREDGE: less DREDGE means more Bass, and vice-versa.

If you want to use an external power supply, either get a Dredge-Tone ultra-linear, distributed, regulated Pedal Board Power Source, or a standard 9V AC to DC wall supply with a 1/8" positive tip plug.
